CALL FOR MOBILITY FELLOWSHIPS OF THE ERASMUS+ KA203 E-LENGUA PROJECT FOR THE PARTICIPATION IN TECHNICAL AND ACADEMIC TRAINING COURSES IN THE CONSORTIUM UNIVERSITIES

One of the Erasmus+ project E-LENGUA (2015-1-ES01-KA203-015743) objectives is the training of teachers, technicians and administrative staff in the use of new technologies applied in the universities participating in the project (Universidad de Salamanca, Trinity College Dublin, Universidade de Coimbra, Université de Poitiers, Universität Heidelberg, Università degli Studi di Bologna, Cairo University).

The European Commission has established 78 days for these activities, in order to reach the following objectives:

- Contribution to the R+D+I of institutions of higher education in both EU and neighbouring countries;
- Promotion of the transfer of knowledge among experts.

E-LENGUA will finance **13 mobility fellowships** for technical and academic staff of the Partner Institutions to participate in these intensive programmes:

- All Universities will receive 1 to 3 visitors (Cairo none);
- The training events of each institution will be focused in the use of technological resources for the language teaching and learning environments and will have a total expected duration of 5 working days/6 travel days (4 days of course / 2 days of travel);
- Each institution shall propose 1 to 3 courses from its general offer for the candidates to apply. It is possible to offer a complete training programme instead of single courses;
- The training events should take place between September 2016 and February 2017.

The candidates must be teachers, trainers, technicians or administrative staff of a Partner University of the consortium.







The selection of candidates will take place as follows:

- Each university will carry out an internal selection of 1-2 to 4-5 candidates and will make a ranking. Each candidate will select up to 3 courses (or programmes) in different universities and will provide a letter of motivation. They will make clear their first, second and third choice (if they have more than one). The first two candidates of each institution will always have precedence over the others;
- A total number of 13 people will be selected, 2 from each Partner Institution (1 from Cairo University);
- USAL will centralise all applications and propose a distribution of candidates, if possible. The interest and the foreign languages' knowledge of each candidate are crucial for the selection process. In case of coincidence of applications, the letter of motivation will be decisive:
- A resolution with a waiting list determined by priority order will be published and sent to each University;
- Each institution will receive at least 1 candidate up to a maximum of 3 (Cairo none) for its training events.

#### The deadlines are:

- 30<sup>th</sup> May: final offering of each institution (Cairo does not need to do it, since they cannot receive candidates);
- 30<sup>th</sup> June: proposal of the candidates of each institution;
- 15<sup>th</sup> July: selection of candidates.

Once the results are published, the receiving institution should contact the selected candidates to agree on the dates and activities of the training course and should offer them support to organize their stay. The selected candidates, on their hand, should contact their receiving institution to confirm their availability.

Attached hereto as annex a provisional description of offerings, with the possible courses that will take place in the receiving Universities and indicative dates. Programmes may suffer some changes.
